Summer workshops!

Nai Disha In-house workshop- Drawing inspiration from the Delhi Government's Mission Buniyaad programme for schools, Nai Disha organized summer workshops for the children in two separate batches. The first batch was hosted in the morning for boys only and the second one in the evening, for girls.

This workshop was conducted to ensure the holistic development for children across various age groups. The workshop channelled the children's creativity by engaging them in enjoyable activities such as electrical, dance, art, craft, computers etc



Outsourced Theatre Workshop- Ajay Sethi from National School of Drama trained 30 children from the Open School Program in Nai Disha to be part of a play. The children practiced tirelessly for a month under his expert guidance and supervision. Their hard work paid off as they put up a wonderful play called Angrez Masterji, in Punjabi (language) at the Shri Ram Centre in Delhi.

Despite being on a colossal platform, the children performed with confidence, determination and exuberance. All the parents and teachers were proud to witness their children's dedication, hard work and talent.



Other Workshops for children

Cyber Security workshop- Niesh, a Cyber Security major at Champlain college, Burlington took an online session with Nai Disha children to spread awareness on various issues related to the cyber security field.

He highlighted the basic problems existing in the cyber security field, taught how to stay safe from malwares and contagious viruses and how to identify ongoing scams and evade them.

Health Program



Free Eye Camp for Women & Children:

Nai Disha, in collaboration with Vision Spring foundation, organized a free eye camp for young girls and ladies of the women empowerment department and children of our Open school and Mainstream program. **100 ladies and 337 children** took benefit of the free eye camp. The ones in need were given free spectacles after the camp. **66 ladies and 100 children** were offered free spectacles.

Health camp: Team of volunteer doctors from Maulana Azad Medical College and IVPSS conducted a Diwali pollution check survey to see the pollution impact level pre and post Diwali in our children, women and the people of the community



Sunday Clinic

Dr Anuj, our Volunteer Doctor, comes every Sunday for two hours to examine our children, their families and for those who face medical issues. The free clinic is a relief for everyone facing medical and financial challenges. During his visit, Dr. Anuj advises them on necessary medicines and a healthy nutritious diet.



Gynaecologist Sessions

Dr Rashmi, our Volunteer Doctor, comes twice a month to interact with our older girls & ladies of the women empowerment department and make them aware about personal hygiene related issues. She answers the queries and concerns of girls and ladies and later examines the needy ones.

Visit to Learnet Skill centre:

In partnership with National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC), our children of class 10th NIOS visited the Learnet Skill centre, a skill development institute in Okhla. The children got an opportunity to explore various job oriented short courses which also assist in developing required skills.

Our Mainstream child, Neha Mishra completed her graduation from Banasthali Vidyapeth, Rajasthan with flying colours. She bagged first position and was awarded with two gold medals, one for Mathematics and one for Economics. She is also preparing for UPSC exams.



Shikshantar- Udaipur

Four boys of our Open school Program went to Shikshantar Udaipur to train for 18 months non academic fields. The main stay of the program is to provide an environment where they are encouraged to think out of the box and not depend upon conventional thought processes. This freedom of self expression leads to self growth and makes them self reliance.



Clove Dental

Practical and theoretical 3 months Dental Assistant course is offered to our youth (18 years+). **A batch of 23 children** took training. During the training program they were placed at various dental clinics where they got hands on training and experience. After completion, Clove Dental offered 100 % placement to all trainees

Community Outreach

Parent teacher meetings were held thrice in last year to make the parents aware of the various activities, games, sports and skills we provide to their children besides day to day studies. They were also made aware about various health problems and about free Sunday clinic. In Annual day the stalls were set to showcase about various activities and skill clubs.

Community walk was done by children and teachers to spread about opening of admissions at Nai Disha. It was emphasized that parents must send their children to study whether in regular school as per their age or at Nai Disha if the child is over age or have learning gap.

Swachhta drive- As a part of routine our children clean the ground opposite our centre for them to play, assemblies and sports. Through this it is also spread to the nearby community to clean their surroundings on regular basis. A group of senior children with their teachers took a walk around the community to spread awareness on swachhta and personal hygiene.



Impact Report

Nai Disha's first Impact report was launched on 30th July and 6th August 2022. The main intention behind the launch of the report was to express gratitude towards our generous donors and partners who stood by our side during the pandemic and had complete faith in us as well as our work throughout. It also gave us an opportunity to reconnect with them post Covid and showcase the work that we did during the pandemic for the children, women, youth and community.

Various stalls were set up such as garden stall, cooking stall, youth and women hastkala stalls, to display their respective talents. Along with that, we also presented our in-house skill-based activities practiced by the children, such as Tabla, Vocal Music, Theatre, Dance and Taekwondo. All the hard work of the children, women and teachers was greatly appreciated and esteemed by our guests and donors.
